

SGI PRESIDENT'S OCT. 13 ENCOURAGEMENT CREATE FRESH RANKS OF CAPABLE PEOPLE

SGI President Ikeda asks leaders to make raising capable people ‘the focus of our energies in the year ahead.’ This is the key for the kosen-rufu movement’s future expansion.

SGI President Ikeda asked leaders gathered at a Tokyo No. 2 Joint Territory executive conference in Hachioji, Oct. 13: “How do we create fresh ranks of capable people for the advancement of kosen-rufu in the 21st century? I want this to be the focus of our energies in the year ahead.”

He said that a genuine leader is one who is selflessly committed to raising people to shoulder the future. That is the key to realizing the organization’s eternal prosperity and growth.

President Ikeda stressed that in all spheres, it is important to have a firm sense of purpose, always asking ourselves, “What can be done to advance kosen-rufu?” For example, he said, depending on how earnestly those in supporting positions, such as vice leader positions, pray and make careful, considerate efforts, our strength will multiply fivefold or tenfold.

It is also important to define the responsibilities of each leader and to form a solid core of leaders working together in harmony. He further said that when we take swift action and complete each task with care and precision, our momentum toward victory increases.
